The County Club has a long history

The original County Club building was built in 1800 and The County Club was formed in 1882 with 120 members. Charles Dodgson's nephew was a member (1905) which influences the number of Lewis Carrol references around the Club. Today the Club continues the function for which it was founded: a social club where professionals of all shades and political opinion can meet.
